Lesson Plan FC Listening/Speaking

Unit: Beautiful World

Textbook: Top-Notch 3

Learning Outcomes:

• Listening for specific information

• Describes in all major time frames about familiar and general topics

• Actively participates in conversations through proper responses

• Acquires new vocabulary

Review: Cocktail party – give each of the students a slip of paper with a task on it, and they will

all walk around like they are at a cocktail party performing the task they are assigned.

Once they complete it, they will switch papers with someone else.

Overview: Today we are going to talk about the world and different geographic features. Ask the

class to think of geographic features and write them on the board. Give them an example:

ocean

Present: Teach the vocabulary for geographic features and adjectives. p.116 in textbook

Practice: Have the students talk with a partner about a place in your country using the

vocabulary we just learned

Present: Teach the vocabulary that has to do with dangerous situations and animals. p. 114 in the

textbook

Practice: Have the students do Listening activity C on p. 114

Perform/Summary: Mini presentations: Tell about a tourist attraction in your country. Have the

students use the vocabulary.

While the students are presenting, the other students will be playing a BINGO game with

the vocabulary words.

Evaluate: Have the students self-evaluate: How do you think you have improved on your presentation skills during the semester. What do you want to continue to improve?
